

CQ-1-2 CQ-1A SUPER SAFETY SUITCASE

TEST INSTRUCTION

Usually, the equipment is without battery. First, you have to install the batteries on both the suitcase and the remote correctly.

Install the batteries on the suitcase.

1. Open the battery box in the suitcase, fill the battery box with six 1.2V 2# (type C) chargeable batteries or six 1.5V 2# (type C) alkali batteries (the capacity of the alkali batteries should be more than 1200mAh) into the battery box. Then shut up the box. Noted that the batteries cannot be installed oppositely, or will damage the equipment.
2. Turn on the Power Switch, the LED 2 will be on. If it does not work, please check whether the batteries are fixed in the correct way, or the batteries are used up.
3. Check the voltage of the battery. Turn on the power switch and turn off the Shock Switch then press the BATTERY CHECK button 3, both LED 5 and LED 6 will be on. If only one or neither light is on, please change your batteries for new ones. Note: please turn off the shocking switch when checking the voltage.

Notice:

If there are batteries in the suitcase originally (such as CQ-1-2b and CQ-1A-1b), please charge the batteries before using the suitcase. For promoting the using time of the batteries, the first charge time should be 8~10 hours.

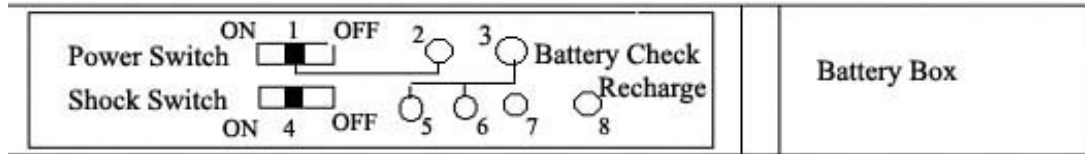


Fig.1 Alarm electric shock box

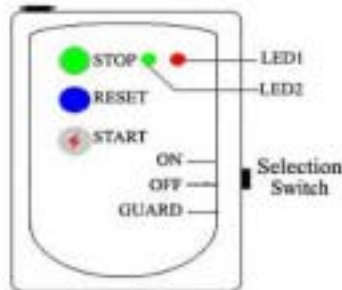


Fig 2. Remote

Install the Battery on the Remote

1. Get rid of the screws on the remote. Open the cover and install the battery (one

12v type 23A battery). Then close it. Noted that the batteries cannot be installed oppositely, or will damage the equipment.

2. Turn the selection switch to ON, and press the button STOP. The LED 1 will be on. If not, please check the way to install the battery, or there is something wrong with your battery.

Anti-robbery Test

1. Turn on the Power Switch in the suitcase. The LED 2 will be on with “tooting”.
2. Turn the Shock Switch to ON in the suitcase.
3. Close and lock the suitcase.
4. Select ON on the remote, and press the START button with “tooting”. Then the suitcase will be alarm and with high voltage electric pulse shock. You can test it with metal tool on the surface of the suitcase, on the handle, between the handle and the lock.

Press STOP button will close the alarm and shock.

If you want to finish the test, please go on to press Off.

Anti-theft Test

1. Turn on the power on the suitcase. The LED 2 will be on with “tooting”.
2. Turn the shock switch to ON if you like.
3. Close and lock the suitcase.
4. Select ON on the remote and press the RESET button with “tooting”, the suitcase will enter into the Anti-stealing mode
5. If you move the suitcase, it will alarm for seconds with high voltage electric pulse shock (Each time it will last several seconds).

You can release this function for pressing the button STOP.

If you want to finish the test, please go on to press Off.

Anti-loss Test

1. Turn on the power on the suitcase. The LED 2 will be on with “tooting”.
2. Turn the shock switch to ON if you like. This is not compulsory.
3. Close and lock the suitcase.
4. Select GUARD on the remote with “tooting”. At the same time, the green LED will be flash the suitcase will enter into the Anti-losing mode
5. Then if the remote you are carrying is 3-15m far from the suitcase, it will alarm. Please note that the shock function does not work in this situation.
6. Release the function. Select ON on the remote, then press the button STOP.

If you want to finish the test, please go on to press Off.

Amendment on the Distance

Normally, the effect distance of the anti-loss function ranges from 3m to 15m. But it is invariable sometimes, because of the different surroundings, such as tall building, which will influence the transmission of the wireless message. So you can change the effect distance according to your requirement. Please note that the distance cannot be beyond 3-15m.

1. Pay attention to the small screw on the upper right side of the remote.
2. The distance can be extended by driving the small screw clockwise, and vice versa.
